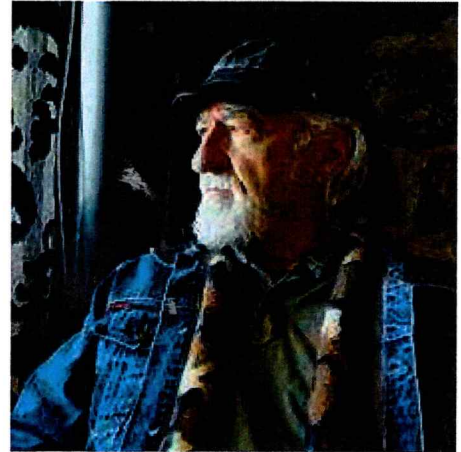

Jameson's prominence as a professional treasure hunter is the result of his discovery of several noted treasures as well as the authorship of more than three dozen best-selling books on the subject. He has also served as a consultant, narrator and on-camera expert for the *Unsolved Mysteries* television show and has also appeared on the History Channel, the Travel Channel, the Discovery Channel, PBS and NPR. In addition, Jameson served as an advisor for the film *National Treasure* starring Nicolas Cage. In 2006, Jameson was inducted into the National Treasure Hunters Hall of Fame. In 2019, he was inducted into the Colorado Authors Hall of Fame. During the fall of 2020 he appeared as a regular contributor in a new television series titled *Beyond Oak Island*.
