The County Commissioners meet every Tuesday, and the club hopes to speak in front of the Court regarding the metal detecting ban.

August Executive Meeting:

We were informed by Roy Turley, Travis County Parks Division Manager, that there is an agenda item at the upcoming Commissioner's meeting Aug. 8 to discuss the prohibition of metal detecting in the parks. He indicated that we are welcome to attend Court so that our concerns can be heard. As yet there is not an approximate time for this agenda item. We will definitely plan to attend Court on the 8th. Larry and Blaine will speak on behalf of the club. **All club members are urged to participate in this important effort by attending court on Aug 8, contacting the commissioners and/or providing information or a written testimony we can share with the court.**

We continue to get requests for member assistance to locate lost items – usually jewelry items. So far the club has been able to accommodate or provide assistance in some way to each request. Thanks to those who have participated with this public service effort.
